
There are two ways of accessing voicemail messages and options.

## Accessing voicemail from the wireless device:

- 1. Press and hold the dedicated voicemail access key. (This is typically the number "1" key.)
- 2. When the voicemail system picks up, interrupt the greeting by pressing the pound key (#).
- 3. When the voicemail system prompts for the password, enter it and wait a few seconds. (The temporary password is "1111".)
- 4. Below are the available options and menu items to choose from once the password has been accepted. If there are any problems, please contact Customer Care **1-866-293-4634** for further assistance.

#### Accessing voicemail from a landline phone:

- Power the wireless device off and place a call to the wireless number. Alternatively, if the wireless
  device cannot be powered off, allow the incoming call to ring several times and forward to the
  voicemail system.
- 2. When the voicemail system picks up, interrupt the greeting by pressing the pound key (#).
- 3. When the voicemail system prompts for the password, enter it and wait a few seconds. (The temporary password is "1111".)
- 4. Below are the available options and menu items to choose from once the password has been accepted. If there are any problems, please contact Customer Care **1-866-293-4634** for further assistance.
